



Total Population


- The median age (half are younger, and half older, than this age) is 35.4 years for people in Mangere Bridge. The median age in Auckland is 35.1 years.
- 12.9 percent of people in Mangere Bridge are aged 65 years and over, compared with 11.5 percent of the total Auckland population.
- 23.7 percent of people are aged under 15 years in Mangere Bridge, compared with 20.9 percent for all of Auckland.

RELATIONSHIP STATUS




Total population aged 15 years and over

- 39.3 percent of people aged 15 years and over living in Mangere Bridge have never married, 42.6 percent are married, and 18.1 percent are separated, divorced or widowed.
- 25.3 percent of people in Mangere Bridge aged 15 years and over who have never been married live with a partner.

Total population aged 15 years and over


- For people aged 15 years and over, the median income (half earn more, and half less, than this amount) in Mangere Bridge is \$28,400. This compares with a median of \$29,600 for all of Auckland.
- 39.5 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Mangere Bridge have an annual income of \$20,000 or less, compared with 39.0 percent of people for Auckland as a whole.
- In Mangere Bridge, 25.9 percent of people aged 15 years and over have an annual income of more than \$50,000, compared with 29.2 percent of people in Auckland.

FAMILY STRUCTURE




Family type

- Couples with children make up 46.3 percent of all families in Mangere Bridge, while couples without children make up 28.1 percent of all families.
- In Auckland, couples with children make up 46.5 percent of all families, while couples without children make up 35.1 percent of all families.
- 25.6 percent of families in Mangere Bridge are one parent with children families, while one parent with children families make up 18.4 percent of families for Auckland as a whole.

Family type

- In Mangere Bridge, 60.1 percent of households in occupied private dwellings owned the dwelling or held it in a family trust.
- For Auckland as a whole, 61.5 percent of households in occupied private dwellings owned the dwelling or held it in a family trust.
- For households in Mangere Bridge who rented the dwelling that they lived in, the median weekly rent paid was \$300. This compared with \$350 for Auckland.
