
TERRITORY MAP | GISBORNE CENTRAL

## AGE AND GENDER




### **Total Population**

- The median age (half are younger, and half older, than this age) is 37.1 years for people in Gisborne Central. The median age in Gisborne District is 37.0 years.
- 17.7 percent of people in Gisborne Central are aged 65 years and over, compared with 14.0 percent of the total Gisborne District population.
- 20.4 percent of people are aged under 15 years in Gisborne Central, compared with 24.6 percent for all of Gisborne District.

## RELATIONSHIP STATUS




## Total population aged 15 years and over

- 42.3 percent of people aged 15 years and over living in Gisborne Central have never married, 33.1 percent are married, and 24.6 percent are separated, divorced or widowed.
- 31.3 percent of people in Gisborne Central aged 15 years and over who have never been married live with a partner.

### Total population aged 15 years and over


- For people aged 15 years and over, the median income (half earn more, and half less, than this amount) in Gisborne Central is \$23,900. This compares with a median of \$24,400 for all of Gisborne District.
- 41.3 percent of people aged 15 years and over in Gisborne Central have an annual income of \$20,000 or less, compared with 41.9 percent of people for Gisborne District as a whole.
- In Gisborne Central, 16.7 percent of people aged 15 years and over have an annual income of more than \$50,000, compared with 19.6 percent of people in Gisborne District.

## **FAMILY STRUCTURE**




## Family type

- Couples with children make up 31.9 percent of all families in Gisborne Central, while couples without children make up 38.2 percent of all families.
- In Gisborne District, couples with children make up 37.2 percent of all families, while couples without children make up 35.0 percent of all families.
- 30.3 percent of families in Gisborne Central are one parent with children families, while one parent with children families make up 27.8 percent of families for Gisborne District as a whole.

## Family type

- In Gisborne Central, 47.9 percent of households in occupied private dwellings owned the dwelling or held it in a family trust.
- For Gisborne District as a whole, 59.2 percent of households in occupied private dwellings owned the dwelling or held it in a family trust.
- For households in Gisborne Central who rented the dwelling that they lived in, the median weekly rent paid was \$220. This compared with \$200 for Gisborne District.
